With all submissions, please include your name and mailing address. All samples, queries, and correspondence should be sent to Jackie@LettersandJournals.com. Please put the article in the body of an email along with an introduction of who you are and why we should consider your submission. Most people will send easy email submissions. You can also send brief email queries: Jackie@LettersandJournals.com. No telephone calls. We only accept original submissions for publication. All images must be copyright free. The person submitting material must ensure that no copyright infringement has occurred and verify that all work is their own. Images will need to be hi-res and sent as a JPG, not in a WORD document or as a PDF. We do not accept simultaneous submissions. Publishing on your personal blog will be permitted, after the issue with your material is published, providing you link back to the Letters & Journals website with a reference that the article first appeared there. Our current publishing schedule is twice a year - in the Spring and Fall.
